### **Quorum**

The Annual General Meeting was declared open by the President at 3.15pm upon satisfying the quorum which was deemed in accordance with Article 7.9 of the Constitution.

### **Address by the President of RSAA – Dr Tan**

Dr Tan Sok Chuen opened the Annual General Meeting (AGM) with thanks to the members attending the event. She introduced the school leaders, Madam Elis Tan, Principal of Rosyth School and Ms Poh Hui Ting, Vice Principal of Rosyth School, who will be presenting school events and matters during the first half of the meeting.

### **Address by the Principal – Madam Elis Tan**

Madam Tan thanked the RSAA for inviting her to this meeting and continuous partnership in 2022. She has attended the AGM for the past 7 years and felt the heritage of our school motto Ready to Serve through us. She acknowledged the support the RSAA has done for events such as education and career guidance, staff and teachers for Teacher's Day and fellow Rosythians on Children's Day.

Madam Tan announced he will be moving on to a new role in the public education sector and Mr Suraj Nair s/o Venugopal will be the new principal with effect from 15 December 2022. She hopes for the RSAA to continue their journey in nurturing Rosythians together.

### **Address by the Vice Principal – Ms Poh Hui Ting**

Ms Poh shared what the school has been exercising based on the school vision and I-CARE values. With the opening up and loosening of SMM, the Rosythians are having a great time adjusting to the changes, especially the P2 and P3 levels.

Leading with Vision - This year, the Rosythians explored how they can support one another using their strengths and courageously encourage themselves at the same time. They do so by generously expressing their gratitude, in particular to teachers and parents by thanking them.

In August this year, the school had a visitation from Minister Chan Chun Sing. Student leaders and CCA leaders representing various CCAs had the privilege to host and engage with the minister. Minister Chan interacted with the Rosythians to understand what they want to be when they grow up and why. He also had a conversation session with the teachers and staff of the school.

The school also had the honour of having Rosythian Skyla Lai Cheong win the Lee Kwan Yew Award for All Round Excellence. This is our school's 5th consecutive win in a row. Madam Tan chimed in to mention that the RSAA fund that supports the Colours Award, not only rewards academic scores, it also celebrates other achievements scored well in a broad range like leadership and mentoring. It should be Rosyth's pride that we contribute our skills to the impact of our society, not just academic achievements.

Besides the students, the school staff also exercised this value by attending DATE with Steering Committee and gathered as a team for a learning journey in June 2022. Teachers of different levels had the flexibility to have their learning journeys at various places like the National Gallery, Apple @Orchard, new industries at the One North.

Learning with Passion - With the loosening of restrictions, the Rosythians enjoyed more freedom to pursue their passions. We continued to achieve at the NSG Badminton Champions with Sportsmanship and Championship Awards. The school participated in various NSG events including Track and Field.

Other than sporting events, we participated in the National Schools Chess emerging as the first few places. We joined the inter school debate and Party Math Contest by Raffles Institution. For the Math Olympiad, we won awards from Gold, Bronze to Merit and participated in the Destination Imagination 2022.

For arts and creativity, we won the Best Design Award through the Pei Hwa Design competition and a Core Values Award for the First Lego League. We also won Platinum, Silver and Bronze Awards for the Hwa Chong Infocomm Award.

On this note, Madam Lim mentioned that we have been in the Nanjing e-immersion programme for the past 6 to 7 years. With the opening up of borders, our P5 students managed to fly to Jakarta and Cambodia for this programme. She appealed for connections within RSAA for educational events like these in order to expand our Rosythians exposure.

Serving with Compassion - This value encourages our students to uplift our community through thoughtful and positive actions. Our students participated and performed to the community on Jalan Kayu Day and prepared Thank You cards for our healthcare workers. Ms Poh ended her address with a heartfelt appreciation for RSAA's assistance in the student's holistic development.

Dr Tan gave a token of appreciation to Mdm Elise Tan on behalf of RSAA. Mdm Elis Tan thanked the RSAA and appreciated our thoughtful present. Madam Tan then opened the floor for any questions at the end of the school update. She implored the alumni members to continue to support RSAA and keep the heritage going.

### **Address by the Alumni President – Dr Tan Sok Chuen**

Dr Tan started her address with a quick introduction of the current 2021/2022 office bearers as well as the social and networking events that were held prior to the pandemic. She looked forward to more opportunities this year as the situation improves.

### **Confirmation of Minutes of Last AGM**

Dr Tan proceeded to showcase the meeting minutes of the last AGM held in 2021. The motion was supported by Ms Leaw Wan Bee Janet and seconded by Ms Mr Ng Wei Chean, Ivan.
